

Information to Plan your Visit

- Field Trips can be booked on **Monday** and **Tuesday Mornings** year round.
- The Sherman requires a **1:10 ratio** of adults to students.
- **Minimum** 8 students
- **Cost** \$5 per student: no charge for teachers and chaperones.
- Scholarships and Bus Subsidies are available.
- **Payment** should be made on or before scheduled Field Trip. We accept checks and credit cards. Please do not bring cash.
- **Cancellation** with full refund is possible up to 14 days before the scheduled Field Trip.
- **Buses** should drop off at 9.30am at our South Lot (corner of Third Ave and Dahlia Ave)
- Field trip duration is **90 mins**
- Students can then eat in the Lunch area for 30mins
- **Buses** should collect students from our **South Lot** at 11.45am.

Preparing for your visit:

- Review our 'Habitat Explorers' Study Guide and review vocabulary with the class.
- Please use the **Class List** template to separate your students into groups. Bring the class list on the day of your field trip. Please make sure you write comments on the class list. This ensures that our Garden Educators will teach your students appropriately.
- Please give your students a **Name Tag** before arrival.

On the Day:

Parking

General Parking for cars at Sherman Library & Gardens is available free of charge: South Lot (on the corner of Third Ave and Dahlia Ave) North Lot (on the corner of Fourth Ave and the Dahlia Ave)

Bus Drop Off and Parking

Buses should arrive promptly at 9.30am and can drop off in the **South Lot** (on the corner of Third Ave and Dahlia Ave)

Lunches should be dropped off at this time.

During the Field Trip buses can remain parked in the **South Lot** in the designated bus parking area.

Tour Group Size

• Students will be divided into groups which will not exceed 10 students. They will be supervised by one Garden Educator and an adult chaperone from the visiting school.

Increased Sanitation Practices

Physical Distancing and Masks

- Physical distancing will be maintained as much as possible.
- Children will be required to wear masks when on the Sherman Library & Gardens, except when eating and drinking.
